 - 3. Does the student need case management services based on findings?
 - a. Develop and Implement appropriate Emergency Action Plan, Medication Orders, and serve through general school health services if Case Management not indicated.

 - 1. Develop Plan of Care

 - c. NASN Use of Individualized Healthcare Plans to Support School Health Services
 - 2. Implement plan
 - 3. Evaluate and revise for care or return student to general School Health Services (Tier Two)
